

# The role of the Nurse practitioner in optimizing care for children with Congenital Adrenal Hyperplasia

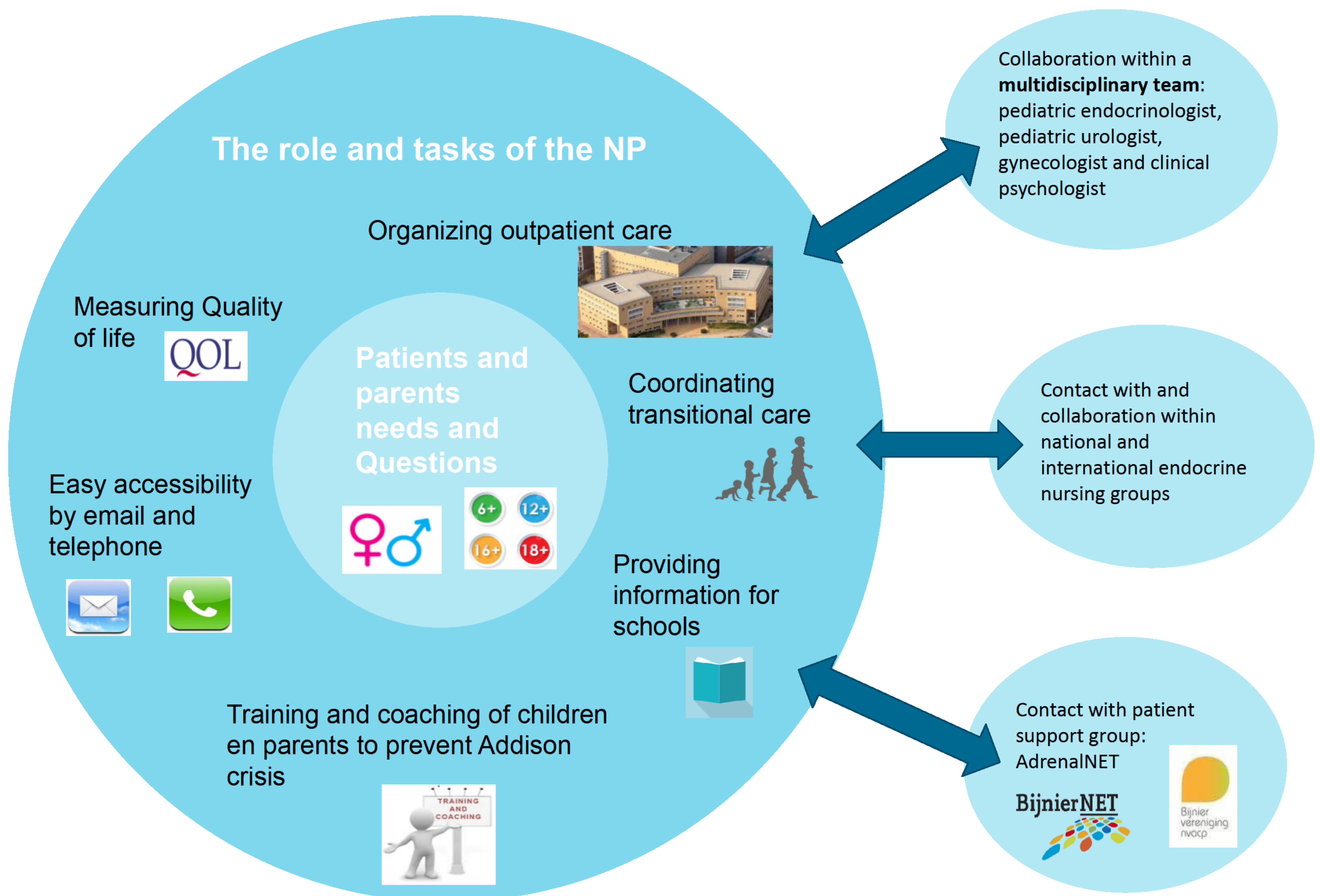
